Make the Difference Cwm Taf - matching people's skills with local groups

What do local groups do?

Community and voluntary groups and charities in Rhondda Cynon Taf and Merthyr Tydfil (collectively known as Cwm Taf) are the lifeblood of local communities. There are over 1000 local groups carrying out incredible work in Cwm Taf. Every day they support a whole range of good causes including befriending older people to reduce loneliness, helping struggling families to support their children and keeping open community facilities such as museums and libraries.

Why do they need help now?

With austerity leading to valued public services being withdrawn or cut back, a growing older population, changes to welfare and increasing poverty, more and more people need the support of local groups. At the same time, there is less funding available to support what they do and increased regulation.

How can you help?

Currently, many groups struggle to carry out their work as they do not have enough support to help them to effectively run their group. Make the Difference project aims to increase the capacity and resilience of community and voluntary groups in Cwm Taf so that they can meet the challenges they face. Make the Difference project will recruit and match suitable trustees with local groups in Cwm Taf where they are most needed.
